The ASEAN Centre for Energy (ACE) and dmg events were honoured to co-organise the 2021 edition of the ASEAN Energy Business Forum (AEBF) held in conjunction with the 39th ASEAN Ministers on Energy Meeting (AMEM) and hosted by the Ministry of Energy Brunei Darussalam.

Conducted online from 14-16 September 2021, ASEAN Energy Business Forum 2021 Virtual presented the single most important ground breaking event for the global energy industry and specifically for South East Asia – the epicenter of energy transition and transformation.
